What is your favorite Holiday/Tradition?

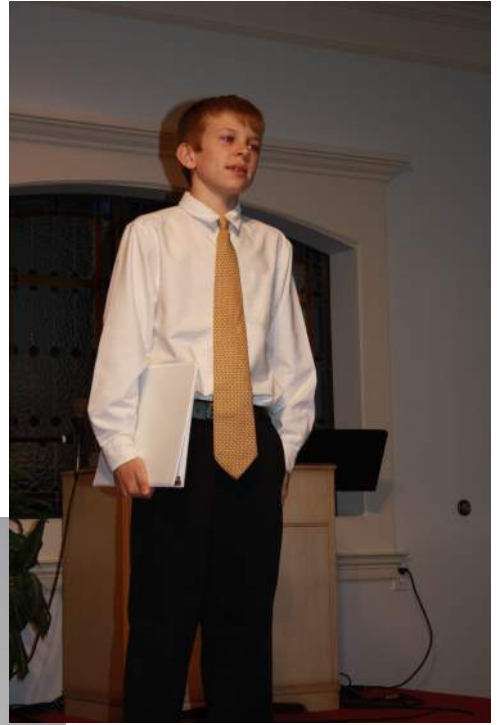
We don't have a favorite holiday; we love all of them, and celebrate them all. Our family tradition is having Sunday dinner at our house or my dads. Family time is very important to us!

Baked Spaghetti

Ingredients:

1 lb. Ground Beef
2 garlic cloves
1 medium onion
2 eggs
Meatless spaghetti sauce
1-pkg spaghetti noodles
1 tsp. Italian seasoning
½ tsp. seasoning salt
5 T. butter
3 c. Mozzarella cheese
1/3 c. Parmesan cheese
1 container ricotta cheese

Instructions:

Cook spaghetti. Cook meat, garlic, and onion over medium heat, until done. Drain meat. Add sauce, seasoning salt, and Italian seasoning. In a bowl, whisk eggs, Parmesan cheese, and butter. Drain pasta, and add to egg mixture. Toss to coat. Place half the spaghetti mixture in a 9x13 baking dish (greased). Top with half of the ricotta cheese, meat sauce, and mozzarella cheese. Repeat layers. Cover and bake at 350* for 30 minutes. Uncover and bake for 10 minutes longer. Enjoy!
